



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Glassbridge Enterprises Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Glassbridge Enterprises Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 15% points. The greatest weakness of Glassbridge Enterprises Inc is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 25% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 60%, being 32% points below the market average of 92%.
