





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Wright Investors Service Holdings Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Wright Investors Service Holdings Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Cash and Current Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 562% points. The greatest weakness of Wright Investors Service Holdings Inc. is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 79% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 202%, being 215% points above the market average of -14%.
