



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Pzena Investment Management Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Pzena Investment Management Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 219% points. The greatest weakness of Pzena Investment Management Inc. is the variable Other Compr. Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 107% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 154%, being 167% points above the market average of -14%.
