



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Sculptor Capital Management Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Sculptor Capital Management Inc compared to the market average is the variable Operating Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 14% points. The greatest weakness of Sculptor Capital Management Inc is the variable Labor Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 17% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 77%, being 14% points below the market average of 90%.
