





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Cosmos Group Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Cosmos Group Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 6.7% points. The greatest weakness of Cosmos Group Holdings Inc is the variable Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 70% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 6.8%, being 84% points below the market average of 90%.
