





The relative strengths and weaknesses of LM Funding America INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of LM Funding America INC compared to the market average is the variable Cash and Current Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 83% points. The greatest weakness of LM Funding America INC is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 43% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 88%, being 5.3% points above the market average of 82%.
