The relative strengths and weaknesses of Curo Group Holdings Corp are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Curo Group Holdings Corp compared to the market average is the variable Investments, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 103% points. The greatest weakness of Curo Group Holdings Corp is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 167% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 17%, being 23% points below the market average of 41%.
