





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Acadian Asset Management Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Acadian Asset Management Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 19% points. The greatest weakness of Acadian Asset Management Inc is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 27% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 79%, being 10% points below the market average of 90%.
