



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Bridge Investment Group Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Bridge Investment Group Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 10% points. The greatest weakness of Bridge Investment Group Holdings Inc is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 23% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 81%, being 8.5% points below the market average of 90%.
