



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Hershey CO are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Hershey CO compared to the market average is the variable Other Liabilities, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 5.3% points. The greatest weakness of Hershey CO is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 27% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 154%, being 27% points below the market average of 180%.
