



The relative strengths and weaknesses of American Shared Hospital Services are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of American Shared Hospital Services compared to the market average is the variable Property Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 163% points. The greatest weakness of American Shared Hospital Services is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 38% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 257%, being 223% points above the market average of 34%.
