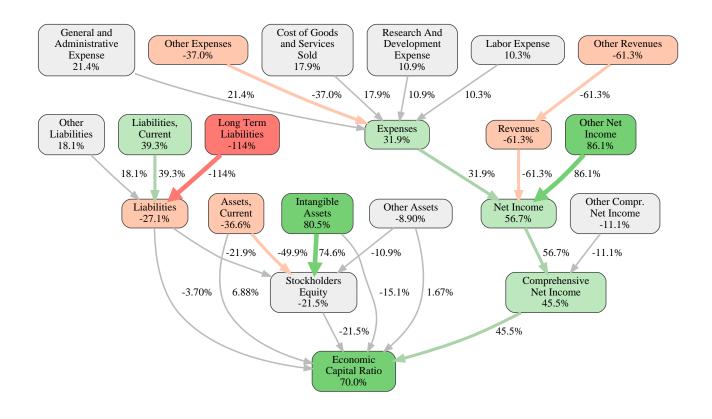


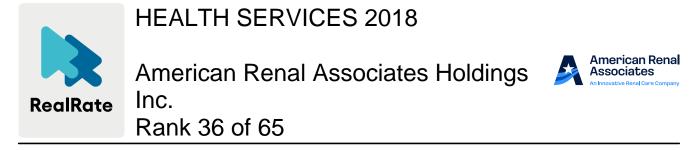
American Renal Associates Holdings Inc.

The relative strengths and weaknesses of American Renal Associates Holdings Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of American Renal Associates Holdings Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 86% points. The greatest weakness of American Renal Associates Holdings Inc. is the variable Long Term Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 114% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 53%, being 70% points above the market average of -17%.
