

## NATIONAL HEALTHCARE CORP Rank 27 of 73

The relative strengths and weaknesses of NATIONAL HEALTHCARE CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of NATIONAL HEALTHCARE CORP compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 84% points. The greatest weakness of NATIONAL HEALTHCARE CORP is the variable Labor Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 92% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 185%, being 152% points above the market average of 32%.
