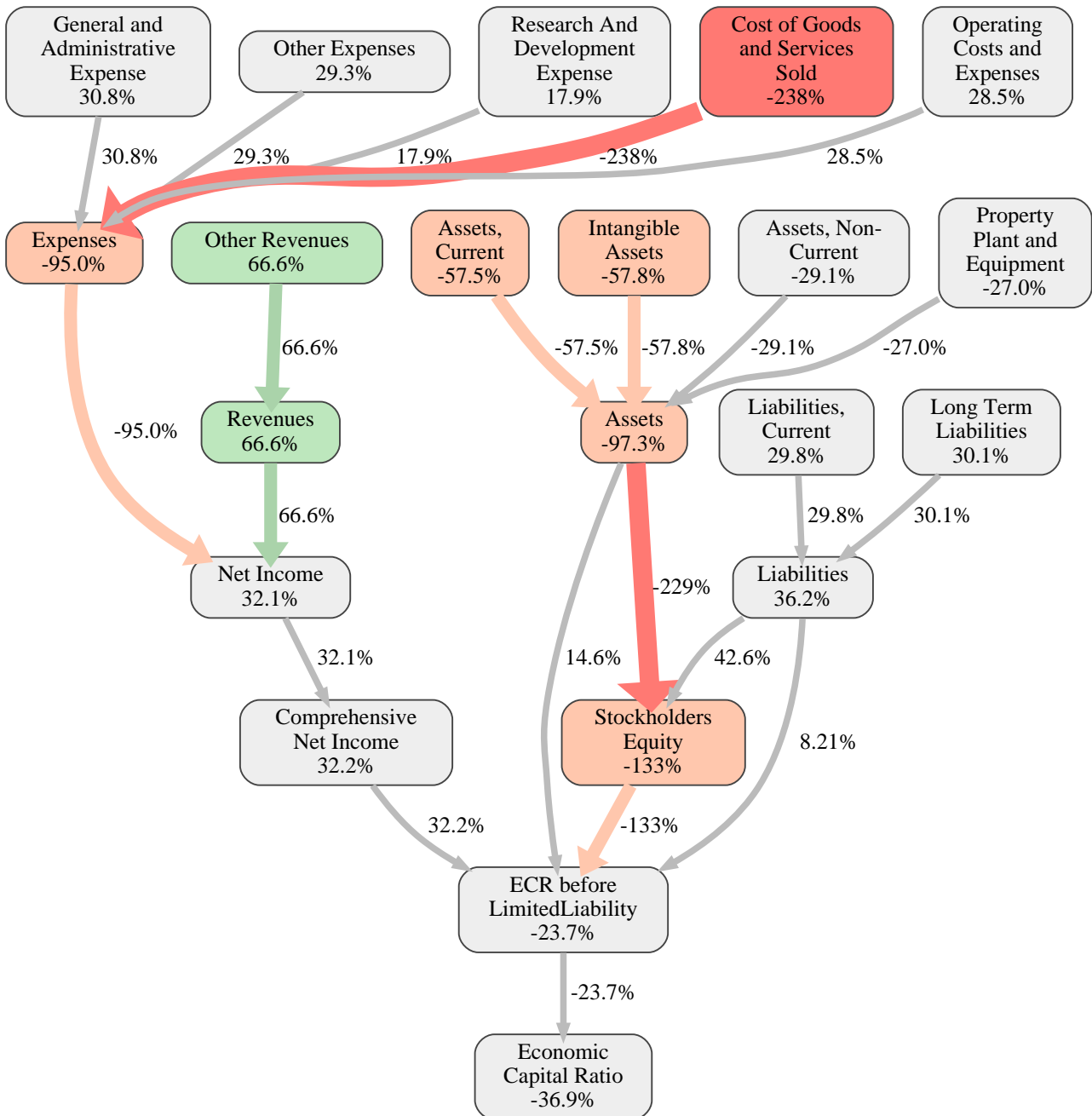

## American Oncology Network Inc Rank 45 of 67

The relative strengths and weaknesses of American Oncology Network Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of American Oncology Network Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 67% points. The greatest weakness of American Oncology Network Inc is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 238% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 117%, being 37% points below the market average of 154%.
