The relative strengths and weaknesses of Oncology Institute Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Oncology Institute Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 35% points. The greatest weakness of Oncology Institute Inc is the variable Operating Costs and Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 186% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 83%, being 67% points below the market average of 150%.
