



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Independence Holding CO are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Independence Holding CO compared to the market average is the variable Premiums Earned, Net, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 24% points. The greatest weakness of Independence Holding CO is the variable Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 25% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 41%, being 14% points above the market average of 27%.
