



The relative strengths and weaknesses of ENERGY FUELS INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of ENERGY FUELS INC compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 71% points. The greatest weakness of ENERGY FUELS INC is the variable Cost of Revenue, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 21% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 106%, being 150% points above the market average of -45%.
