



The relative strengths and weaknesses of General Moly Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of General Moly Inc compared to the market average is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 66% points. The greatest weakness of General Moly Inc is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 18% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 160%, being 206% points above the market average of -47%.
