

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Allison Transmission Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Allison Transmission Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Goodwill, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 46% points. The greatest weakness of Allison Transmission Holdings Inc is the variable Liabilities, Noncurrent, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 74% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 104%, being 5.6% points below the market average of 110%.
