


MOTOR VEHICLE PARTS 2014

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The relative strengths and weaknesses of LEAR CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of LEAR CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 48% points. The greatest weakness of LEAR CORP is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 49% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 112%, being 9.7% points above the market average of 102%.
