

MOTOR VEHICLE PARTS 2014



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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Cooper Standard Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Cooper Standard Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 34% points. The greatest weakness of Cooper Standard Holdings Inc is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 23% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 99%, being 3.3% points below the market average of 102%.
