



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Tesla Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Tesla Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Other Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 97% points. The greatest weakness of Tesla Inc. is the variable Liabilities, Noncurrent, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 72% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 27%, being 58% points above the market average of -31%.
