


MOTOR VEHICLE PARTS 2021

Tesla Inc. Rank 18 of 56







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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Tesla Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Tesla Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 288% points. The greatest weakness of Tesla Inc. is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 261% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 125%, being 117% points above the market average of 8.6%.
