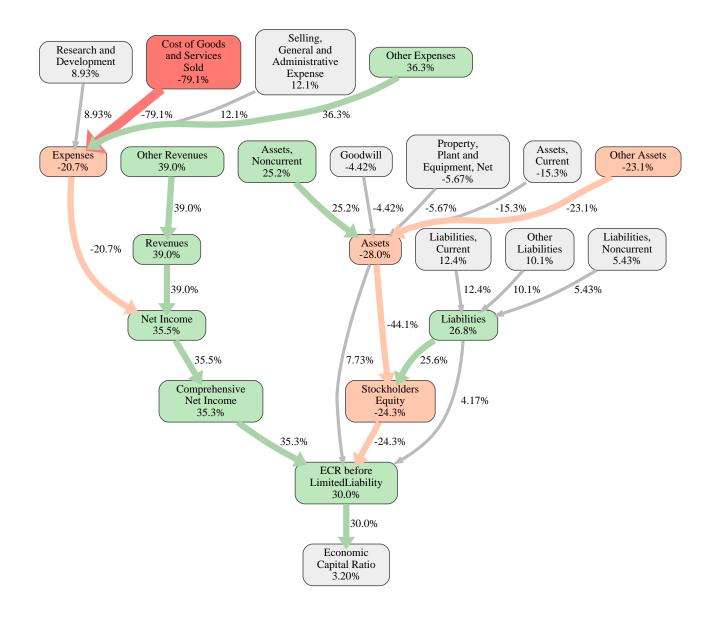

LEAR CORP Rank 20 of 46



The relative strengths and weaknesses of LEAR CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of LEAR CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 39% points. The greatest weakness of LEAR CORP is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 79% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 100%, being 3.2% points above the market average of 97%.
