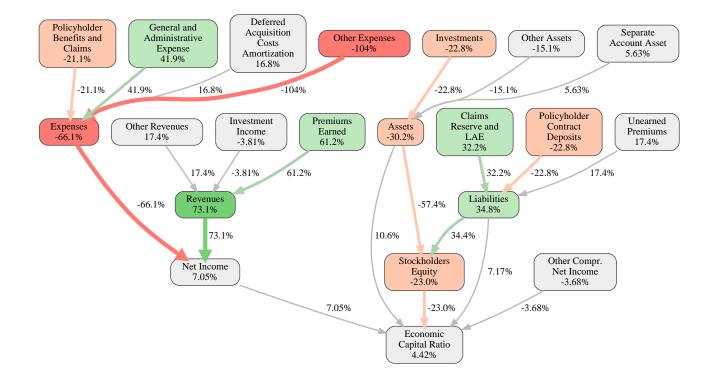

NON-LIFE INSURANCE 2018

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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Cigna Holding Co are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Cigna Holding Co compared to the market average is the variable Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 73% points. The greatest weakness of Cigna Holding Co is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 104% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 36%, being 4.4% points above the market average of 32%.
