

Goodrich Petroleum CORP Rank 40 of 40

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Goodrich Petroleum CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Goodrich Petroleum CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 13% points. The greatest weakness of Goodrich Petroleum CORP is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 77% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 20%, being 121% points below the market average of 141%.
