



The relative strengths and weaknesses of CHESAPEAKE ENERGY CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of CHESAPEAKE ENERGY CORP compared to the market average is the variable Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 22% points. The greatest weakness of CHESAPEAKE ENERGY CORP is the variable Long-term Debt, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 60% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -42%, being 90% points below the market average of 48%.
