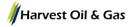
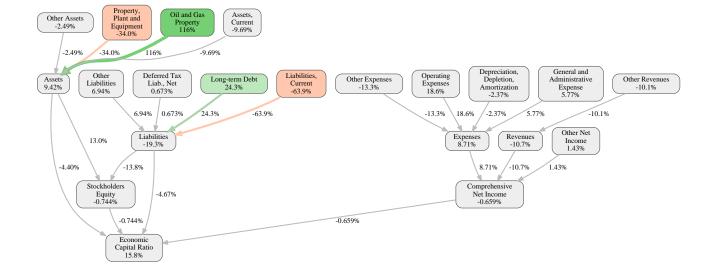

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Harvest Oil & Gas Corp. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Harvest Oil & Gas Corp. compared to the market average is the variable Oil and Gas Property, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 116% points. The greatest weakness of Harvest Oil & Gas Corp. is the variable Liabilities, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 64% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 71%, being 16% points above the market average of 55%.
