

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Trillion Energy International Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Trillion Energy International Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 63% points. The greatest weakness of Trillion Energy International Inc. is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 78% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -7.3%, being 62% points below the market average of 55%.
