





The relative strengths and weaknesses of OCCIDENTAL PETROLEUM CORP DE are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of OCCIDENTAL PETROLEUM CORP DE compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 49% points. The greatest weakness of OCCIDENTAL PETROLEUM CORP DE is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 35% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 174%, being 95% points above the market average of 79%.
