

CHESAPEAKE ENERGY CORP Rank 83 of 103





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The relative strengths and weaknesses of CHESAPEAKE ENERGY CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of CHESAPEAKE ENERGY CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 65% points. The greatest weakness of CHESAPEAKE ENERGY CORP is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 65% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 13%, being 66% points below the market average of 79%.
