





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Chaparral Energy Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Chaparral Energy Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Oil and Gas Property, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 44% points. The greatest weakness of Chaparral Energy Inc. is the variable Other Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 20% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 188%, being 109% points above the market average of 79%.
