The relative strengths and weaknesses of US ENERGY CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of US ENERGY CORP compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 55% points. The greatest weakness of US ENERGY CORP is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 65% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 151%, being 81% points above the market average of 70%.
