US ENERGY CORP Rank 30 of 84



The relative strengths and weaknesses of US ENERGY CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of US ENERGY CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 29% points. The greatest weakness of US ENERGY CORP is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 53% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 120%, being 51% points above the market average of 69%.
