The relative strengths and weaknesses of HOUSTON AMERICAN ENERGY CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of HOUSTON AMERICAN ENERGY CORP compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 55% points. The greatest weakness of HOUSTON AMERICAN ENERGY CORP is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 26% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 187%, being 118% points above the market average of 69%.
