



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Berry Corp (bry) are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Berry Corp (bry) compared to the market average is the variable Long-term Debt, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 48% points. The greatest weakness of Berry Corp (bry) is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 24% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 170%, being 101% points above the market average of 69%.
