





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Intra-Cellular Therapies Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Intra-Cellular Therapies Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 117% points. The greatest weakness of Intra-Cellular Therapies Inc. is the variable Research and Development, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 29% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 197%, being 161% points above the market average of 37%.
