



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Epizyme Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Epizyme Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 86% points. The greatest weakness of Epizyme Inc. is the variable Research and Development, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 17% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 218%, being 182% points above the market average of 36%.
