



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Minerva Neurosciences Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Minerva Neurosciences Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 105% points. The greatest weakness of Minerva Neurosciences Inc. is the variable Research and Development, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 17% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 296%, being 248% points above the market average of 47%.
