





The relative strengths and weaknesses of COMPUTER PROGRAMS & SYSTEMS INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of COMPUTER PROGRAMS & SYSTEMS INC compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 135% points. The greatest weakness of COMPUTER PROGRAMS & SYSTEMS INC is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 135% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 130%, being 94% points above the market average of 36%.
