





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Sysorex Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Sysorex Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Research and Development Expense, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 9.4% points. The greatest weakness of Sysorex Inc. is the variable Assets, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 195% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -463%, being 477% points below the market average of 13%.
