



The relative strengths and weaknesses of IAC Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of IAC Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 87% points. The greatest weakness of IAC Inc. is the variable Other Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 16% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 388%, being 362% points above the market average of 26%.
