

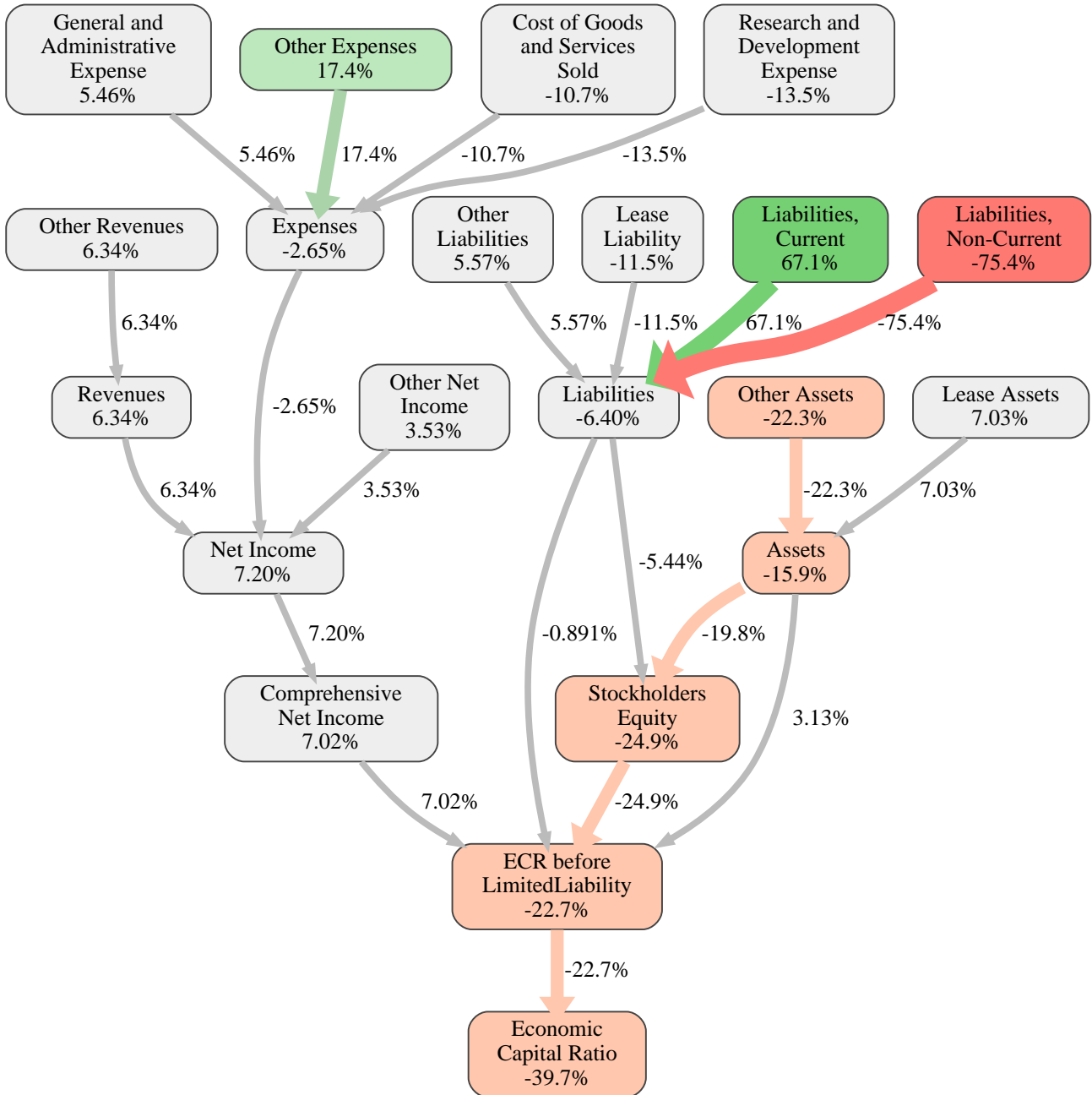

# Snap Inc.





The relative strengths and weaknesses of Snap Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Snap Inc compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 67% points. The greatest weakness of Snap Inc is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 75% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 186%, being 40% points below the market average of 226%.
