



The relative strengths and weaknesses of SANTA FE FINANCIAL CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of SANTA FE FINANCIAL CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 414% points. The greatest weakness of SANTA FE FINANCIAL CORP is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 197% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -73%, being 177% points below the market average of 104%.
