





The relative strengths and weaknesses of TRANS WORLD CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of TRANS WORLD CORP compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 327% points. The greatest weakness of TRANS WORLD CORP is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 291% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 191%, being 486% points above the market average of -295%.
