

The relative strengths and weaknesses of SeaWorld Entertainment Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of SeaWorld Entertainment Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 170% points. The greatest weakness of SeaWorld Entertainment Inc. is the variable Operating Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 143% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 25%, being 320% points above the market average of -295%.
