





The relative strengths and weaknesses of BUTLER NATIONAL CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of BUTLER NATIONAL CORP compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 468% points. The greatest weakness of BUTLER NATIONAL CORP is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 477% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 230%, being 479% points above the market average of -250%.
