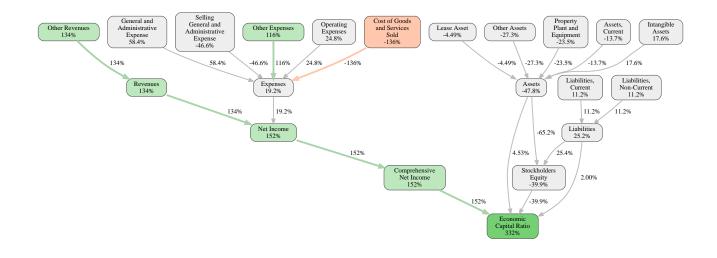

## Warner Music Group Corp. Rank 18 of 39

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Warner Music Group Corp. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Warner Music Group Corp. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 152% points. The greatest weakness of Warner Music Group Corp. is the variable Cost of Goods and Services Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 136% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 23%, being 332% points above the market average of -309%.
