

The relative strengths and weaknesses of DEERE JOHN CAPITAL CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of DEERE JOHN CAPITAL CORP compared to the market average is the variable Deposits, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 25% points. The greatest weakness of DEERE JOHN CAPITAL CORP is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 61% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 6.5%, being 2.6% points below the market average of 9.1%.
