

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Discover Financial Services Rank 28 of 93

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Discover Financial Services are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Discover Financial Services compared to the market average is the variable Loans, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 17% points. The greatest weakness of Discover Financial Services is the variable Other Assets, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 14% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 9.3%, being 0.19% points above the market average of 9.1%.
